The **SALISBURY FESTIVAL** is celebrating its **TWENTY EIGHTH YEAR**. It is one of the largest festivals in the Delmarva area and continues to be a special way to celebrate the coming of spring, the enjoyment of dance, music, good food, and various forms of art. The festival has always provided many diverse opportunities for the non-profit organizations and clubs in the Salisbury area to make money to fund programs that benefit our community. We continue to attempt to improve and make the festival an enjoyable and new adventure for everyone.

We hope to make a big splash with artists and crafters located on the festival grounds. Booth locations will be in the Plaza area. **The number of vendors in the area will be limited.** The Festival's Arts on The Plaza Committee reserves the right to make all final decisions regarding exhibitors' acceptance and placement. The committee reserves the right to remove any exhibitor who does not adhere to the rules and regulations set forth here.



Exhibitors

All applicants are requested to submit photos of their work, if available. The committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Entrance will be subject to acceptance. All applications are due by Friday, March 26, 2010. Applications received after that date shall be placed on a waiting list. For return of your photos, a self-addressed, adequately stamped envelope must be provided.



Regulations

- ❑ All craft items must be original (no kits, imports, or pre-manufactured items). All media are acceptable: acrylics, collage, watercolor, pen/ink, pencil, photography, sculpture, and print. Exhibitors cannot display work not made by them, but consortia of artists sharing a booth space are acceptable.
- ❑ All artists, professional or amateur, may exhibit contingent upon the decision of our Arts on The Plaza Committee.
- ❑ All sales and sales tax are the responsibility of the artists and craftmakers. Each exhibitor must have a current Maryland tax number and have it available if a state representative should request it during the festival. Artists will be able to acquire a one day permit from the Comptrollers Office, contact Dee at 410-767-1540. Tell them you are participating in the Salisbury Festival, they will take some info. and issue a permit.
- ❑ All applicants are expected to bring any and all equipment needed for their space, such as tables, chairs, standards, etc. It is recommended that plastic coverings be brought in the event of rain showers.



Space

Each exhibitor will have up to 10" x 10" for each space requested. **Space locations will be first come first serve.** If you can be flexible with the shape of your exhibit space, please indicate that to us. It will help us to more easily accommodate the artists and craft makers. **If you require more than 15 minutes to unload please let us know.**



Exhibit Hours

Exhibitors are expected to leave exhibits up for the entire Saturday of the Salisbury Festival according to the times designated for their assigned area. You will be notified of your exact exhibit space location and instructions for unloading and parking.

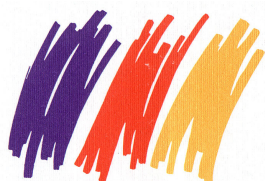
